New Jersey VFW Members

The VFW members of New Jersey are the heart and soul of any program. In membership you are the frontline, you will do the bulk of all recruiting. If any assistance is needed you can contact members or the Recruiting Retention team. Membership will only be successful if we all do our job.

Each District Commander is to appoint a District Membership Chairman. It will be his/her job to be the contact between the NJVFW Membership Chairman and the District. I ask each District Commander to put in a motivated hard chargers as their membership chairman.

NJVFW MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM

Category 1 Post with 75 member or less.

- Any Post that reaches 100% by 10/31/18 shall receive \$300.
- Any Post that reaches 100% by 12/31/18 shall receive \$200.
- The next 40 posts that reach 97% in membership by March 15, 2019 shall receive \$100.

Category 2 Post with membership of 76 to 125 members.

- Any Post that reaches 100% by 10/31/18 shall receive \$400.
- Any Post that reaches 100% by 12/31/18 shall receive \$275
 - The next 30 posts that reach 96% in membership by March 15, 2019 shall receive \$150.

Category 3 Post with membership of 126 to 200 members.

- Any Post that reaches 100% by 10/31/18 shall receive \$500.
- Any Post that reaches 100% by 12/31/18 shall receive \$400
- The next 20 posts that reach 94% in membership by March 15, 2019 shall receive \$250.

Category 4 Posts with membership of 201 to 300 members.

- Any Post that reaches 100% by 10/31/18 shall receive \$800.
- Any Post that reaches 100% by 12/31/18 shall receive \$600
 - The next 15 posts that reach 93% in membership by March 15, 2019 shall receive \$450.

Category 5 Posts with membership of 301 to 400 members.

- Any Post that reaches 100% by 10/31/18 shall receive \$1000.
- Any Post that reaches 100% by 12/31/18 shall receive \$800 -Posts that reach 93% in membership by March 15, 2019 shall receive \$600.

Category 6 Posts with membership over 400 members.

- Any Post that reaches 100% by 10/31/18 shall receive \$1500.
- Any Post that reaches 100% by 12/31/18 shall receive \$1000
- Posts that reach 93% in membership by March 15, 2019 shall receive \$800.

Post Commanders in Category 1 and 2— The first post commanderwith highest percentage in membership by March 1, 2019 over 102% will receive airfare and hotel accommodations to the VFW National Convention in Orlando Fla July 21-24, 2019.

Post Commanders in Category 3 and 4 – The first post commanderwith highest percentage in membership by March 1, 2019 over 101% will receive airfare and hotel accommodations to the VFW National Convention in Orlando Fla July 21-24, 2019.

Post Commanders in Category 5 and 6 – The first post commander with highest percentage in membership by March 1, 2019 over 100% will receive airfare and hotel accommodations to the VFW National Convention in Orlando Fla July 21-24, 2019.

If a post commander is unable to attend the trip to National Convention in Orlando, he/she may designate another person from their post.

When a post attains their membership percentage in their respective category, the assigned District Monitor (see page 4) will contact the Post Commander/Quartermaster to advise them of the award. Only one membership award will be awarded to a post. The only exception to this is if the post wins the trip to National Convention. The District Commander will be advised of all awards.

If feasible, monetary awards to the Post will be awarded to that post by a State Officer, District Monitors or a District Commander.

If after several attempts the District Monitor and subsequently the respective District Commander and NJVFW Dept HQ does not make contact with the respective Post Commander/Quartermaster, the award monies will be held in abeyance.

Districts

Category A Districts under 1000 members - 1, 3, 15, 18, 19, 21

- Any District reaching 100% in membership by3-1-19 shall receive \$750.00

Category B Districts with membership between 1000-2000 – 4, 5, 6, 7, 10, 16, 17

- Any District reaching 100%in membership by3-1-19 shall receive \$850.00

Category C Districts over 2000 members -2, 8, 11, 12, 13

- Any District reaching 100% in membership by3-1-19 shall receive \$950.00

First District to 100% - The commander will receive airfare and hotel accommodations to the VFW National Convention in Orlando Fla July 21-24, 2019. If the Commander is unavailable to attend the award can go to the Sr Vice, Jr Vice or Quartermaster of the district only.

If feasible, monetary awards to the Post will be awarded to that post by aState Officer, District Monitors or a District Commander.

The size of Post/District membership will be determined as of Post/District membership as of June 30, 2018.
